<p>The proposed development to build up to 50 homes is ludicrous. The access to the site is on an already dangerous bend at the top of a very narrow road with very few passing places and no pavement except on the approach to Station Road. It is currently a very busy road which is dangerous to use whether you are a pedestrian, cyclist, horse rider or car driver, especially in winter when it is very often extremely icy. None of the roads in and around Stocksmoor is suitable for the amount of construction traffic which would be required to build such a development. Never mind the noise and dirt which would be associated with a huge building site. There would also be an unacceptable increase in the amount of residential traffic once the houses were built. 50 additional houses in such a small village would change the character of the village substantially. They would also impact massively on the local doctor and schools - in particular the middle and high school which are already full to bursting. This is totally inappropriate for the proposed site and must not be allowed to happen.</p>
