I am a young person living in Stocksmoor and would like to object to this planning application.

I love living in Stocksmoor because we are surrounded by fields with lots of wildlife living in them. I often see owls, deer, rabbits. The field where these houses are planned to be built is where lots of these animals currently live so this will be destroying their homes and it is also used for sheep.

We have done about planning new houses at school and new developments should encourage the new residents to walk to places rather than use their cars but you can't really do that in Stocksmoor as the shops and schools are down a road that is not very safe to walk on. There is a lot of traffic on it and often cars get stuck passing each other and when I walk on this road it always feels unsafe. I used to cycle on this road to Shepley but I don't like it because there are too many cars and there will be even more if 50 houses are built right next to this road.

The entrance to the site is on a dangerous bend and you can't see cars coming up the road.

You can't really get a bus to the shops as they don't go there and also they aren't very often, probably one every two hours. Also the trains are only once an hour but quite a lot of times they are cancelled.

I think this plan will change the village as it will mean a lot more houses. It is better to have it as a field for the farmer to use for grass to feed his animals and to put his sheep on.

There will be an increase in the amount of noise and pollution. In the woods at the bottom of this site, there is a stream which will be in danger of being polluted.

This application should not be allowed and these houses should be built somewhere more suitable.
