I have lived in Stocksmoor with my Mum and Dad, since 1993, when I was 2 years old.

I want to object to the new development on Shepley Road. Our roads are already busy, narrow and steep with lots of single track. Some people drive too fast. My best friend was killed at the crossroads in 2002. Our roads are dangerous. Stone Wood Lane is the worst and Dam Hill is bad too, with no pavements and some cars going too fast, especially as there are tractors, vans and 4 x 4s. In winter, cars are left abandoned in Stone Wood Lane in ice and snow. Gritters can only do the bus route to Huddersfield. The other lanes are too narrow. The top of Dam Hill is difficult, because of parked cars in front of the cottages and an awkward junction onto the A629. There is no really good alternative to Stone Wood Lane, for going south. When there are roadworks, there is chaos. Everyone has to drive to the shops, schools, health centres and dentists. The schools are full already and Shepley is oversubscribed

There is plenty of land for building in the town, without spoiling the countryside.
