<p>Our house, which has been in situ for around 250 years and is adjacent to the new Stocksmead development, is an example of how poor planning decisions can impact on current residents and their properties having been the subject of ASBOs/high hedge legislation as a result of this new development.</p> <p>Due to this, I support the current residents of Stocksmoor as I believe this development will have a negative impact on their properties, the enjoyment of their properties, in addition to their mental health.</p> <p>I have a child in Year 2 at Thurstonland First School. The maximum capacity per year group used to be 12; there are now 15 pupils in Year 2, demonstrating that some year groups are already beyond saturation. Therefore the local school would be unlikely to accommodate additional children of families moving to the new development.</p> <p>I regularly walk my dog via Stone Wood Lane, and use this road on a daily basis to drive to my workplace in Sheffield and also to visit the local Coop. The road is dangerous, too narrow, has no footpaths etc. The increase in houses along Shepley road would increase the amount of traffic along this hazardous route, thereby increasing the risk of incidents and accidents.</p>
