<p>My main objection to this development relates to impact on highway safety and traffic.</p> <p>The "working from home phenomenon" is now dissipating and I, amongst others, drive to work down Shepley Road / Stone Wood Lane in morning and evening rush hour four days per week.</p> <p>The traffic congestion is already unacceptable and additional houses will make this worse. The likelihood of residents to use this road is very high. On the occasions that I use the train (at these hours) there is often standing room only due to students going into Huddersfield. More residents will make this issue worse, so it will negatively affect commuters either way.</p> <p>The bend where the entrance and exit to the proposed development is dangerous enough now, without more cars trying to join Shepley Road / Stone Wood Lane from the side. I am surprised that anyone would propose using this entrance on a large scale, where it was presumably agreed historically for one of two agricultural vehicles to enter the field.</p> <p>The proposed site is not appropriate for the reasons stated above and I hope it is rejected.</p>
