<p>As a daily dog walker I am concerned about the impact on highway safety and traffic caused by this development.</p> <p>Stocksmoor is a lovely village but the amount of traffic that passes through is disproportionate to the number of residents. Crossing the road at the junction of Cross Lane and Shepley Road / Stones Wood Lane is very difficult and cars come from all directions at too high speed. I am very concerned that any increase in the volume of traffic would make the village unsafe for walkers.</p> <p>Traffic pollution is a concern to me and adding extra vehicles into a small village in the countryside would be a strange decision and not in keeping with the character and atmosphere that is valued by so many.</p> <p>I do drive down Shepley Road / Stone Wood Lane and I find it quite intimidating. It is already quite heavily used and more cars will make this route an unacceptable one to use. This would route cars to Dam Hill which is already a difficult area to exit from.</p> <p>I strongly object to this development and think it should be dismissed out of hand.</p>
