Video of sewer flooding onto Garganey Trust land, Thunderbridge on 27 January 2026

The video was filmed at 1211hrs on 27 January 2026, in Thunderbridge, West Yorkshire,

We confirm that the video in the link is the video referred to in _____ proof of evidence.

The footage was shot from the path across Garganey Trust land, which initially runs broadly parallel with Thunder Bridge Dike and with Thunder Bridge Lane.

In the far background, as the camera pans, can be seen part of the roof of the Woodman Inn. Beyond that is the main part of Hartley Bank Wood (Ancient Woodland).

The video shows outflows from a manhole cover on the combined sewer that runs across Garganey Trust land.

Based on the Yorkshire Water map, this manhole cover is positioned broadly in line with the back of No.6 Thunder Bridge Lane (the small building which can be seen with a flat roof).

The outflows can be observed travelling along the path and then flowing to the right, into the Dike.

The video also shows the water from the Dike coming onto another section of the path a little upstream from the manhole cover.

At this point, the main section of Hartley Bank Wood is behind the Woodman Inn and behind Thunder Bridge Lane. A little further on, Thunder Bridge Lane bears off to the right (up to Penistone Road).

At this point, Thunder Bridge Dike starts to delineate the boundary of a separate section of Hartley Bank Wood (also Ancient Woodland). This separate section used formerly to be known as Lower Hartley Bank Wood.
