5 x 6m Columns (C7 - C11)
Each carrying 1 x Urbino 14W LED Lantern (303 Optic, 3K)
Post top mounted, 0 degree elevation.

8 x Wall mounted KH15GLX22U3KBY
22W Luminares 3K
Mounted at 6m high (W1 - W8)

6 x Wall mounted KH15GLX22U3KBY
22W Luminares 3K
Mounted at 5m high (W9 - W14)
