| <p>I would like to object to the changing or removal of the conditions set by the planning authority for the use and resurfacing of the car park areas and access lane, at Holmfirth Tech.</p> <p>For the following reasons;</p> <p>1, I would like very much my parking space returned. I currently park at the foot of my garden wall. To park here causes myself and Tech users an inconvenience. I have to perform more manoeuvres to park and the area is drastically reduced in width, for other car park users. There was never a problem before. The previous owner of my house parked in the car park, from 2001 to 2014. I have parked in it from 2014 to 2022. I have rights, generated through long use, that are been taken away from me.</p> <p>2, There needs to be a restriction on the lane. There is no reason to use the car park 24hrs a day and it gives the residents no peace and quiet. We have always been able to protect our peace and quiet in the past. For example, during the tour de France 2014, a chain was placed across the entrance on the Sunday. This gave the residents ownership of the lane which has, with the new owners, become a grievance.</p> <p>3, The new businesses at the Tech have generated a lot of babies and buggies, pedestrian traffic. This means extra diligence for motorists and parents. There is no room on the ramp for a car and a pushchair and visibility is poor for both motorists and pedestrians.</p> <p>4, The car park can get very congested and becomes a needless compromise for residents and Tech users alike. A restriction on who uses the car park is needed. This would make it less congested, increase visibility and make it safer for the buggies.</p> <p>5, For me personally, a compromise could be reached if, justly, my rightful parking space is returned.
