<p>Dear Kirklees planning Department, I wish to submit comments in support of this planning application for the erection of a canopy and store.</p> <p>I see no problem with the addition of a small weather canopy tucked around the back of the house, that is built in a sympathetic styling that complements the original building, i.e., genuine Yorkshire stone roofing slates and an open timber frame made from oak.</p> <p>I think it's worth pointing out that when the "beautiful Grade II listed barn at Heady Fields" was redeveloped by Anthony Dearnley Homes Ltd, he added an artificial stone slate roof, plastic guttering, double glazing and Indian stone flags around the properties. These are certainly not in keeping with a Grade II listed barn, but have been allowed in the interests of the redevelopment and future enjoyment of the property.</p> <p>I note in another comment to this planning application that there is an objection to a 2m high fence, after obtaining a copy of the restrictive covenants I see no mention of any height restrictions on any fence. The same comment also says that the fence is "visibly obtrusive from the golf course", I would think most golfers would be more concerned with "overthinking their swing" or "poor posture" rather than the height of a fence or even the addition of a small weather canopy.</p>
