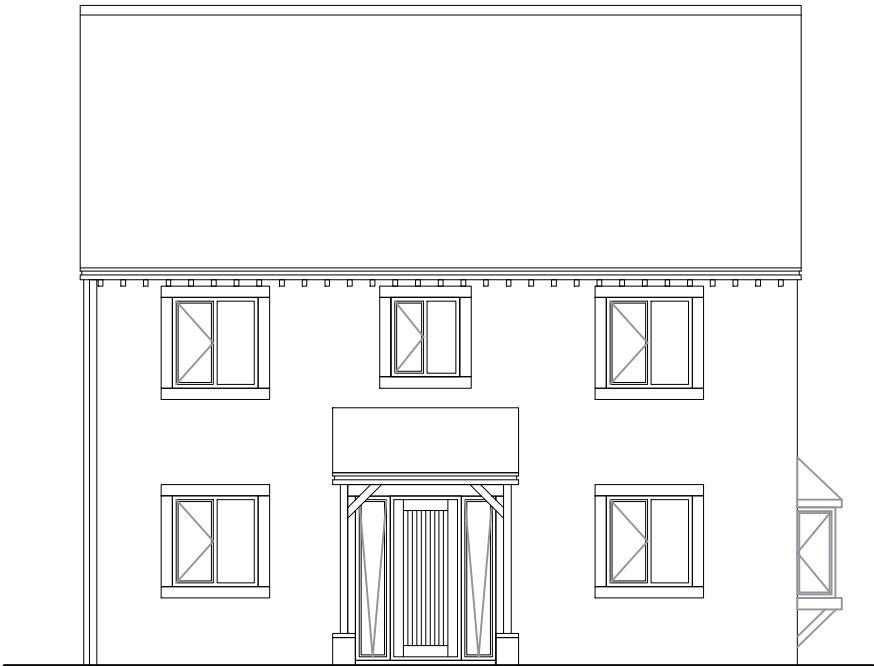




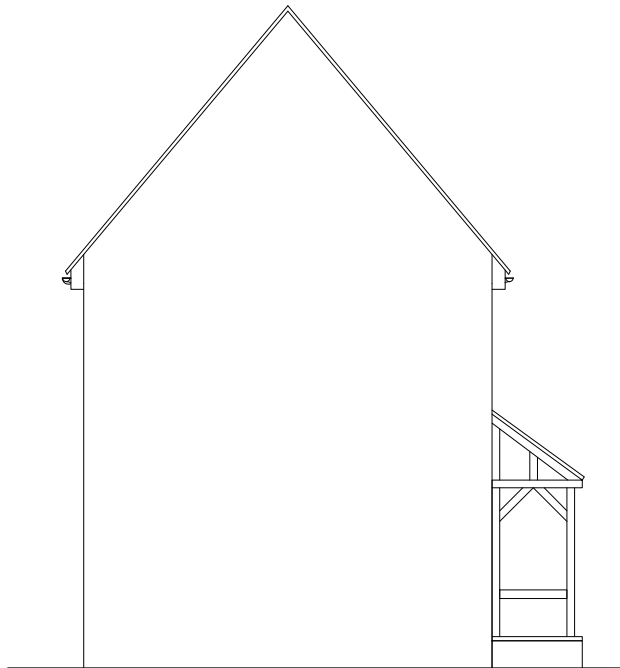
Front Elevation

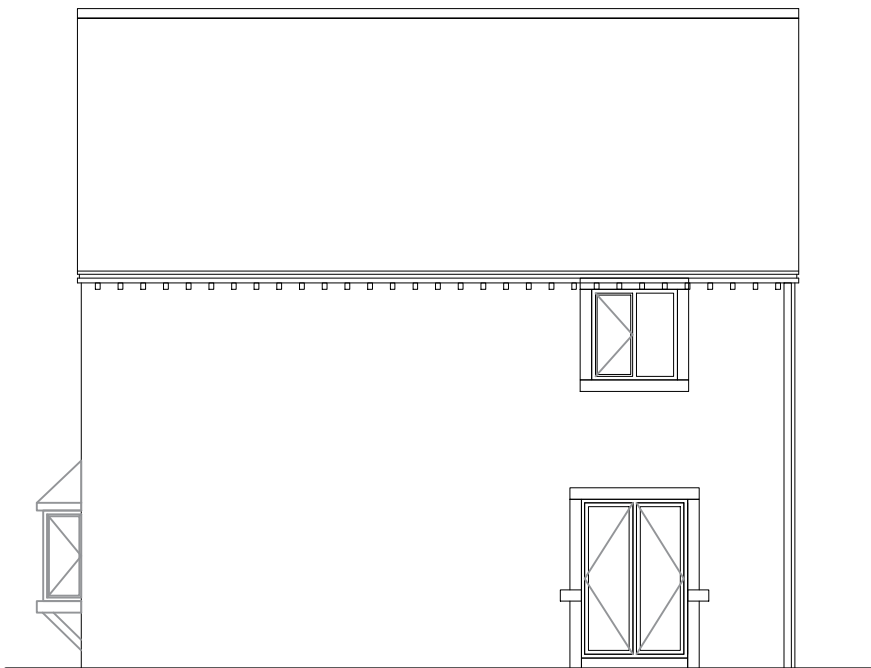
Side Elevation
