<p>I wish to object to the planning for the following reasons;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pavements are in adequate for any further residential homes. They are too narrow for pedestrians to walk safely and totally unsuitable for disable users, or for parents using pushchairs. In some places there is no pavement at all or is less then 600mm across.2. Anti-social parking at the entrance to Walker Street is already problematic, without introducing any further traffic.3. Anti-social parking outside the Spangled Bull at the top of Long Lane is again problematic for existing traffic.4. Long Way is narrow and is not suited to additional traffic, including both work vehicles (HGV's and vans) whilst the constructions is carried out and additional residential traffic.5. Street Lighting is poor the entire length of Long Lane.6. Overgrown hedges growing onto footpaths, forcing pedestrians to walk in the Road.7. Earlsheaton Infant School is already over subscribed.8. Public Transport, there is no public transport in the immediate area, with the nearest Bus Stop located along Town Street, forcing car ownership or an increase in pedestrians having to walk in the road (Long Lane).
