| <p>There would be a lot of noise from the hens. There would also be a lot of noise from the ventilation units. The smell would be unbearable. There is a big risk of disease. Concern of pollution entering the water course that runs from Clough Head Junior School adjacent to Bolster Moor Road and round the back of Bolster Moor Farm. Despite there already being a new entrance from Drummer Lane to the farm the new building would require another entrance/exit onto Drummer Lane, so increasing traffic onto a road which doesn't have any public footpaths, which would increase the danger to the public who use the road for recreational walking. Also a greater risk to the children from the school and local nursery.
