<p>Oi Dumplings is a fantastic addition to our village. Marsden has very few real restaurants (particularly in comparison to neighbouring Slawit) and many pubs/restaurants/cafes in the village have closed in recent years. Therefore, the news that a vibrant new restaurant from a team that have already built a following from their smaller venue was incredibly exciting and exactly what the village needs.</p> <p>To block this application for extended opening hours would be absurd - what restaurants close at 6pm? This is the time most people want to eat a meal.</p> <p>It is not proposed to be a bar or club, it is a restaurant where families can go to eat a lovely meal with a drink and then go home (or to the pub!). Oi Dumplings does not attract a "rowdy" customers.</p> <p>While there may be an slight increase in volume from normal group conversation in the venue, it must be acknowledged that this is reasonable as the restaurant is in the middle of the main street of the village - it is a commercial not a residential street. While there are one or two residents above shops, it is unreasonable for them to expect the rest of the village to be quiet from 6pm. (If people don't want to experience noise after this time then it may be best not to live on a commercial street). There are several other venues (bars/pubs and our only other restaurant) that all open after 6pm and it is rare that excessive noise spills out.</p> <p>It is vital that Kirklees Council does whatever it can to support local businesses that will add so much to our village and community. We need more places like this in Marsden for the village to grow and develop. Refusing this application will severely impact the success of this business and the livelihood of its owners and any employees. It would also deter others from investing or planning businesses on Peel Street.</p> <p>I urge Kirklees Council to approve this application and not allow the objection of one next door neighbour to hinder the growth of this business or our village.</p>
