I attended the address, 59 Cornmill Lane , Liversedge, WF15 7DZ

I was present to give my professional opinion on a Horse Chesnut tree located to the side of the property.

Upon inspection it is clear to see there is visible deadwood. There is a large limb what leans out towards the public highway and it appears to be dead. The whole tree is suffering from decay and severe decay surrounds the bottom of the trunk which on closer inspection seems to have penetrated deep into the tree.

It is my opinion that the tree has some form of disease and along with the severe rot/decay at the base of the tree, it should therefore be removed immediately on the grounds of health and safety. It is in close proximity to the property and public footpath so would pose a serious risk if left standing.

The public footpath is used regularly and neighbouring properties park vehicles along the roadside directly under the tree in question.
