One of the trees, a Laburnum, is riddled with Ganoderma and stands in the middle of an outdoor area used frequently by church groups. The other is a maple which is stone dead, on the top of a retaining wall with a bit of a drop to the road below. Ideally I would like to received a 5 day notice & get the work scheduled in.
