N.B. I do not want my postal address to be published. I wish to strongly object to the demolition of 30 Lightridge Road. The building is a good example of a late Georgian / early Victorian domestic residence that survives in sound condition and is an asset to the local area of Fixby as one of the few older buildings to be retained. It should be considered as a Non-Designated Heritage Asset, and would be a clear contender for inclusion on a Local List. There is no sound justification for its needless demolition, and retention, reuse and restoration should be the preferred option. In addition to its local heritage value and its positive contribution to the historic character of Fixby and its grouping with Griff House, the former coach house to 30 Lightridge Road, demolition does not align with central and local government carbon reduction targets and pledges. The carbon emissions associated with demolition, and its environmental impact, are great and there is no justification in this instance when the building is in good condition and eminently capable of being retained.
