Thank you for consulting Sport England in respect of the further details submitted under the above planning reference to discharge condition 21.

Condition 21, which secures the details of the construction, surfacing, line markings and means of enclosure of the pitch, was requested by Sport England when we provided comments on the original planning application (2021/90357) on the 2 November 2021.

### **The views of the National Governing Bodies for Sport**

As part of the assessment of this consultation, Sport England has sought the views of the following National Governing Bodies for Sport. The Governing Bodies act as Sport England's technical advisors in respect of their sport and their sport facilities.

The comments of the Football Foundation (FF) who provide observations to Sport England on behalf of the Football Association (FA) have been summarised as:

- *FF understand the technical information provided by S&C Slatter sufficient to discharge condition 21.*
- *The FF has no further comment.*

### **Sport England's assessment of the planning condition**

As can be seen from the comments of the FF above, acting as Sport England's technical advisors in respect of football facilities, the submitted information in respect of condition 21 is acceptable to discharge condition 21.

Sport England notes that a detailed document has been submitted titled 3G ATP Design and this is the document that has been reviewed by the FF.

Sport England **no objection** to the discharge of condition 21.
