<p>St Helens Gate is a small road with very heavy traffic usage. It is the only road serving King James Grammar school and has very heavy pedestrian usage. There has been work done to control traffic and try to alleviate the high risk of accident to pedestrians and school children. This scheme provides for 10 car parking spaces within the plot. This is wholly inadequate for 8 apartments. It is highly likely that the majority of apartments will have more than one car per apartment meaning that all excess cars are more than likely to park on the road outside the plot increasing the difficulty of negotiating the road safely.</p> <p>As a local who uses this road ( but tries to avoid it ) I consider it completely unacceptable to create even more demand on this road particularly considering the narrowness of the road and the tight bends on this part of the road. A single dwelling is one thing but 8 apartments and all that comes with them?</p>
