<p><u>Comments</u></p> <p>The current permission is for the petrol filling station to operate between 0700hrs to 2200 hrs Monday to Saturday and 0900hrs to 1700hrs on Sundays. The proposal is to extend these times to 0530hrs to 2300hrs daily.</p> <p>The applicant has submitted an undated Noise Assessment authored by Infinity Acoustics Ref A175MF. It identifies the site and surroundings with the nearest noise sensitive receptors (NSRs) shown in figure 1. The assessment considers the noise from vehicle movements, petrol pumps, tannoy systems, noise from car radios, tyre pumps and car door slams.</p> <p>A noise survey of the site was undertaken between Friday the 19th of July to Monday the 22nd of July 2024 from a single measurement position as shown in figure 4 and a summary of the findings is given in table 5. A BS4142 assessment has been conducted and after applying a total of +8dB corrections for tonality, intermittency and impulsivity, table 7 shows a low impact. The findings of the report are accepted.</p> <p>Section 4 details the following control measures -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The filling station should not operate outside of 0530hrs to 2300hrs daily. Should the petrol station need to operate outside of these hours then further assessment may be required. • The tannoy speaker system should not be utilised in the nighttime hours between 0530hrs to 0700hrs. • The fuel delivery time periods should remain the same and should not occur within the proposed extended hours of operation. • Any car valeting and/or hoovering facilities and car washing should only be used within the existing permitted hours of operation. <p>A condition is recommended to secure these measures in the interests of protecting amenity.</p> <p><u>Recommended Conditions</u></p> <p>NC13 Operate in accordance with agreed plan – Condition</p> <p>The development hereby approved shall be operated in accordance with the measures specified within the Noise Assessment authored by Infinity Acoustics Ref A175MF.</p> <p>Reason: To ensure the proposed development does not cause harmful noise pollution within neighbouring noise sensitive locations, in the interest of amenity, to comply with the aims and objectives of Policies LP24 and LP52 of the Kirklees Local Plan and Chapters 12 and 15 of the National Planning Policy Framework.</p>
