We propose to demolish the existing side garage and construct a micro side extension solely to accommodate a bathroom. The new extension will measure approximately 1.2 meters by 2.8 meters. This development aims to increase open space around the property and will be set back at least 1 meter from the boundary wall. The previous garage was positioned directly adjacent to the boundary wall, and the new setback will enhance the spatial openness and aesthetic of the property. This extension will adhere to all relevant building regulations and local planning policies.
