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Hi there, hope you're well. I've liased with Nick Goddard for a number of years but have realised he has now left the department.

I have a dead Elm tree in the front Garden which boarders onto the main road.

This street is a busy road for the local School run and I'd like to remove the Elm and the adjacent Sycamore which over hangs the road/wall and re plant with two new Elm trees in the winter months for the future maintenance of the front garden and the species itself.

I will of course plant the Species which can survive the Dutch Elm Fungus.

I have a tree surgeon available to carry out the work and wanted ask permission to carry the work.

My concern is that the tree has rapidly changed in the last few weeks as shown and has recently shed a few branches

I was hopeful the tree may regain its health but sadly not.
