<p>I am very concerned about the amount of increased traffic and the impact on residents surrounding this development as Blackmoorfoot road is already a very busy road and even following the recent addition of double yellow lines, vehicles are still parking on both sides of the road and on the pavement making the road extremely difficult to navigate, particularly at peak times causing hold ups. When also taking into account the proposed future development of Industrial units on the old Lowdhams leisure site, which is situated just down the road (off Blackmoorfoot rd and Crosland Hill Rd) and which will further increase traffic levels in all directions, I do not feel that enough thought has been put into the full impact of exactly how much extra traffic this development will create when considering most households now have 2 vehicles. I note that the traffic assessment (fig2) has stated how local amenities are accessible by foot or bicycle, in reality I cannot believe that you really think people are going to walk the distances stated! I am also concerned about any additional traffic using Crosland Hill rd as a 'rat run' to and from Manchester road as this road consists of many terraced houses with no driveways and therefore have no option but to park on the road, making the road extremely narrow and again already causes problems with the amount of traffic using it.</p>
