<p>I believe this application will disrupt the conservation of the natural environment namely by increase of lighting, noise and damage to natural habitats to wildlife. Additional street lighting and lighting from homes will increase light pollution.</p> <p>The effect on trees and the landscape will be disturbed and therefore have an impact on the appearance and layout of the character of the area. The village is small with a small school and no immediate local amenities to support a development of this size when also taking into consideration the additional application also submitted for 12 homes.</p> <p>The additional noise, disturbance pre, during and post construction will have a negative effect on wellbeing, the environment and nature.</p> <p>Furthermore, there will be a severe negative impact on highway safety as many pedestrians use Denby lane for horse riding as there are ample fields used as livery's, dog walking (due to no pedestrian footpaths) and bike riding. Many small children use the single lane too, which could increase the risk of accidents. Highway access the site will be limited to Denby lane and Ben booth lane, which are the only highways to access the dwellings in the locality of the proposed application and traffic will be increased. It is worth noting that Ben booth lane is also a single track highway, with no street lighting, no footpath.</p> <p>The application is not suitable for the area.</p>
