<p>The applicants have had in excess of three years to finalise drainage plans for this application. Obviously they are attempting to play the system as they knew all of the requirements at the initial stages, including the fact that Scheduled Monument Consent must be obtained before any start is made, regardless of planning consent.</p> <p>No other iron age fort in the country has ever been considered for development - they are very strictly controlled and even archeological work needs to be fully authorised by the relevant authorities.</p> <p>This application for changes to drainage seems to be a continuation of the applicants previous record with this venture to extend the original application beyond the permitted time to gain some advantage by muddying the waters on existing regulations.</p> <p>The area of Castle Hill, during the pandemic and still continuing, is a very family orientated space to exercise, play and enjoy the views and open green spaces. Any work on excavation for drainage would severely impact this and be illegal without Scheduled Monument Consent.</p> <p>We therefore object to this amendment and recommend you reject this application.</p>
