I have no objections to plans for a front porch, even though it is in front of the building line. Nor do I object to the dormer windows, front and back.

However, the intent to change the garage roof from a flat roof to a gabled roof I do, most definitely, object to. Between next door and my property, 5 Greenway, is a footpath on their side and a footpath on mine, each path JUST wide enough to wheel a wheelie-bin down them, plus a very narrow strip of garden on my side. I look on to the flat roof of the garage from my kitchen window and from a small window in the lounge, which is down the side of my bungalow, by their garage. My lounge window, is very close to their garage at that point. A gabled roof will darken my lounge and I would be looking at a wall, albeit a lesser height than the main gable end. We are supposed to be detached properties on Greenway and I would not feel that I was in a detached property if this wall is allowed to be erected and I would be losing light from my lounge.
