Concern about the impact of a dropped kerb to the already strained parking situation in Syringa Street. Our street is a rat run with many speeding cars and impatient drivers at busy times. Residents often have nowhere to park on the street as they are in competition with Parkers who are employees, customers or visitors to the many businesses, shops, cafes, salons, Post Office, dentist, opticians on the main road. People tend to park partly on the pavement on the side of number 36. Backing a car out from a driveway between other parked cars could be very difficult and dangerous and having a dropped kerb would mean only residents or visitors to number 36 would be able to park on the road outside in this spot. It would also create generally less room for parking and manoeuvre generally. Aesthetically it would not be good either. This particular aspect of the planning would affect many residents of the street and I am not sure if many of them know as I only found out from a direct neighbour of number 36.
