Lack of doctors and dentist appointments will be even more of an issue than it already is, currently 2 weeks plus wait for a doctors appointment. Schools in the area are already over subscribed meaning children will have to travel to schools further away, thus increasing the number of cars on the surrounding roads at busy times. Traffic on Ashbourne Drive will increase dramatically and parking is bad on that road already with residents double parking on bends. Traffic on Ashbourne Way will increase dramatically too and people will use the farm track to cut through to the new estate. Children play out on Ashbourne Way and this will put their safety at risk as drivers already tend to speed on this road. The noise and lack of privacy will affect our lives enormously and our property will be overlooked by the new builds. During the building process the noise, dust and pollution will affect the wellbeing of everyone who already lives here. Why are you building on green belt land?
