<p>Previous planning permission given for 47 houses, after objections to 57. This current plan should not increase the number previously granted.</p> <p>The infrastructure of Cleckheaton i.e. roads, schools, GPs and dentists, struggles currently and can not cope with larger influxes of vehicles and children to schools already at their limits.</p> <p>Ashbourne Drive is a busy road and often difficult to navigate due to parked cars. Each new house will no doubt have at least 2 cars each making congestion worse. This is then a hazard to the children currently living on the existing estates.</p> <p>This plan does not meet the need for first time buyer homes or single level homes for the elderly or those with mobility problems.</p> <p>There are bats in the area as well as other wildlife and so there should be fewer homes built to protect nature. We are a nature depleted country.</p> <p>The roads should be ended and not left open for future development to be sneakily built.</p> <p>The construction of new houses could disturb the workings of the old mines in the area and cause subsidence to the houses nearest to the development.</p> <p>Rainwater running off roads and pathed areas into Spen Beck will cause flooding further down stream on flood plain areas that have previously flooded and are now built on.</p>
