<p>The land owner illegally felled trees in January and is still under investigation from the forestry commission. The trees were felled on a weekend so owners of houses on Providence Street/The Laurels were unable to contact the appropriate people to inform them of the trees being felled. No consideration was taken into account for the vast range of wildlife and nesting birds at the time of the felling. It also caused a lot of distress for the owners of properties on Providence Street/The Laurels who were not informed of the felling and have lived with the thriving woodland since the houses were built.</p> <p>I have concerns that the planned houses are multiple story which will heavily overlook the two story/single story houses of Providence Street/The Laurels, as well as blocking out natural light.</p> <p>Providence street is a narrow street for two cars to be able to pass and I have concerns about the congestion the new houses will cause. There doesn't look to be much parking available on the new proposed site and I have concerns that people will park on the already narrow road of Providence Street. I also feel the plans provided are very limited.</p> <p>I hope my concerns over the illegal felling, the height of the houses and the access to the new proposed site is taken into consideration.</p>
