The proposed tree work is excessive and unnecessary to facilitate the development. There is still no objection to the proposed development as it shouldn't impact on the trees however the permission to prune these trees is rejected.

The proposed tree work to T5 is excessive and alternative remedial action hasn't been explored before suggesting the removal of the tree closest to the existing building. Also the proposed work to tree T4 would leave the tree completely one sided and likely unviable in the future. The descriptions of work are also too vague and need to be more specific with their intended work.
