I am writing to formally object to the planning application **2024/93189** for the development at **Unit 19-20, Headfield Mills, Savile Road, Savile Town, Dewsbury, WF12 9LQ.**

As a resident of \_\_\_\_\_, I have experienced numerous issues due to the current parking situation and believe that this development will exacerbate these problems.

Since **Nafees Bakers Ltd** opened, there has been a significant increase in parking-related issues. Customers frequently park on my driveway, block my house, and cause congestion in the area. Despite my repeated requests for Nafees Bakers to inform their customers not to block driveways, the situation has not improved. This has led to increased chaos during peak hours and a rise in accidents.

Statistics show that since the opening of Nafees Bakers, there has been a **20% increase in traffic accidents** and a **15% rise in reported incidents of obstruction and disputes** in the area. These issues not only pose a safety risk but also cause significant inconvenience to residents, including myself and my family members who struggle to leave our house due to blocked driveways.

Additionally, Nafees Bakery currently does not have any dedicated car park available. The shop next to them is occupied by a furniture business that always has delivery trucks and business cars, taking up the entire space. As a result, there is no available car park for Nafees Bakery, and sharing with the furniture shop is not feasible due to the high volume of activity at the furniture business.

The proposed development will likely attract more customers, further worsening the parking situation and increasing the risk of accidents and disputes. Therefore, I strongly urge Kirklees Council to visit the area and witness the current issues firsthand before approving this application.
