<p>I find myself objecting once again to this application.</p> <p>Over the last week the applicant has illegally we believe undertaken the resurfacing and groundworks of a public footpath / ancient bridal way without permission from the council.</p> <p>Quaker Lane the proposed access route has been widened and in doing so has severely cut back land alongside the bridal way thus destroying the habitat of the local wildlife.</p> <p>They have also severely cut back hedgerows of local residents that do not belong to the applicant in attempt to widen the lane without permission of the owners.</p> <p>They have resurfaced the lane with scalping's, Scalping's are hard and sharp and can easily cause lameness in horses if they go at any pace faster than a walk, the bridal way is used daily by the local horse riders so this could be dangerous to both rider and horse, there is a lot of research on this online.</p> <p>The applicants have also been confrontational to local residents who have not only questioned their recent actions but also with regards to the objections on this site.</p> <p>There has also been large heavy goods vehicles delivering materials this week and again this morning to the lane making the bridal way unsafe as this type of vehicle was never intended to use this access.</p> <p>I would like these comments to be taken into consideration by the planning team as the actions taken by the applicant are questionable.</p>
