We would like to object to the above planning application on the following grounds: The proposed development for one residential property is on Green Belt land, but if approved, would no doubt open the way for future planning applications for more residential properties. Access to the proposed development is via Quaker Lane, a narrow bridleway used by pedestrians, horse riders and dog walkers with no passing points for traffic especially emergency vehicles. This bridleway leads down to the Jo Cox Wood which is a quiet haven for visitors who wish to reflect and remember family members commemorated by trees planted there. If future planning development applications are approved, they would have a devastating effect on this unique area because of increased traffic and noise. Applications submitted in the past for development have been refused due to the poor sightline for traffic and pedestrians at the junction of Quaker Lane and Hightown Road.
