I wish to object to the above Planning Application, the junction of Quaker Lane with Hightown Road is only wide enough for one vehicle, it is an unmade road, full of potholes which the few people who live on Quaker Lane have to negotiate every time they leave their property. After the homes, the road becomes a footpath and then a Bridleway for horses. I have been told that the person applying for the new stables and one detached house has had diggers and equipment down the Bridleway cutting back hedges to make the path wide enough for two cars to pass each other. I would assume they will not be the owners of the bridleway so who has given them permission to do this work? This particular area is full of wildlife, close to the Jo Cox Community Woods , it a haven which people enjoy . If this application is passed, I can see that this will be followed by an application to build further houses on this site. This Site was previously H225 in the 2015 Local Plan and was rejected as it was part of the Green Belt.
