Re: Concerns Regarding Proposed Redevelopment at 13 Thornhill Road, HD3 3DD

I am writing to express my serious concerns regarding the proposed redevelopment of the property at 13 Thornhill Road, which adjoins 11 Thornhill Road. My is and the proposed development is causing significant distress. I would like to highlight two key points of concern:

1. Lack of Transparency in Disclosure of Plans

The manner in which the redevelopment plans have been disclosed has been highly concerning. A new set of plans was posted on January 13th, just three days before the end of the consultation period. This raises questions about the thoroughness and transparency of the planning process. For instance, how could such obvious considerations as chimney pots have been omitted from the original plans? This undermines confidence in the management and execution of the proposed build - and even whether other neighbours were aware and have had the opportunity to comment on the revised plans.

2. Invasion of Privacy

The proposed plans include large, second-floor windows that are out of keeping with the aesthetic of the building and the surrounding environment. These windows would result in a significant invasion of privacy for making her feel constantly under surveillance as she enjoys her garden, which has been her pride and joy in recent years.

As a counsellor registered with the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP), I am gravely concerned about the impact of this proposed development on mental health. Since becoming aware of the plans, she has experienced She is now and I am deeply worried about

In light of these concerns, I urge you to reject the current redevelopment plans. The well-being of and the preservation of the community's character must be prioritized.
