This path is frequently utilised by families and residents to access important green spaces and enjoy wildlife and local walks. Children use this path during the summer months, and during snow for sledging, and an increase in large vehicles could compromise safety.

There is a sharp bend in the road where Leymoor Road meets Banks Drive near the proposed site. The lack of pavement, along with the presence of horse boxes and other large vehicles would add safety hazards for pedestrians.

Horses and stables are not out of character for the area, but the access is a concern, as is the boggy nature of the field.
