Safety The entry /exit road is on a very dangerous part of cliffe hill .Cars ,wagons and buses descend the hill at speed and there is not enough room for two vehicles to pass safely at the point near the church.It is a natural bottleneck. I have personally witnessed an accident there last year</p> <p>2 This is one of two proposed developments in adjacent fields with would total 85 houses. This means more people needing to use the already busy local doctors leading to longer waiting times for appointments and treatment for everyone</p> <p>3. The traffic through the village is very busy with large Lorries.All the building work would increase this problem plus we would have another 62 cars at least when the work was done. It is very difficult now to park in the village to use the local businesses</p> <p>4 Leak hall road has had problems with drainage and water cascading down the hill so by taking the natural drainage of the land away could exacerbate these problems .</p> <p>5 There are coal mines under the proposed site and if they are caulked as suggested would this also make the local drainage problems worse?</p> <p>6. We have witnessed bats and other wildlife on the site and would wonder how this would affect their future or would they just be other victims of the transformation of our beautiful village into a town</p>
