<p>These plans have already been rejected twice for the valid reasons mentioned by others here.</p> <p>Namely the extra traffic involved on the dangerous steep hill of Cumberworth Lane which has restricted views and the extremely narrow proposed entrance to the site; the danger of flooding and the open cast mining with grouting remedial works to stabilise the land. Effectively this would mean a concrete jungle of which the runoff which would inevitably add to the flooding issue. None of these issues have been properly detailed by the developers and they seem to have been deliberately vague.</p> <p>To be operating an opencast mining in a village centre is grossly irresponsible, and for the planners to allow this would be environmentally unacceptable.</p> <p>What would this say about the green policies of Kirklees? It would be a total betrayal of the residents of Denby Dale.</p> <p>I urge the council to refuse this development finally.</p>
