<p>The village cannot sustain a coal mine nor the development of 62 more houses. Residential services such as schools and Doctors are oversubscribed with residents waiting months for an appointment.</p> <p>Furthermore, the road conditions are not suitable for the movement of large wagons and machinery necessary to mine the coal. This extra traffic will cause unnecessary disruption to residents, damage road surfaces, and create unacceptable levels of noise. The road leading to the site itself is not large enough for wagons, nor was it built to sustain 62 more households worth of traffic. This will create unsafe highway conditions.</p> <p>In addition, the damage to the environment and wildlife in that area will be irreparable. Mining for coal is an incredibly invasive process and there is no mention of how the coal is to be disposed of. There is a wide variety of wildlife native to Denby Dale and these species and our environment must be protected. Removing this green land will ruin the character of the village and create an eyesore.</p> <p>Such a large upheaval to a green area may cause the surrounding area and properties to flood, as seen previously by the Wood Nook development. This is due to the removal of the trees and greenery which help absorb the moisture.</p> <p>The properties will also overlook the privacy of existing houses.</p>
