<p>Mining coal near the heart of the village near a number of residential properties and well used open areas is not acceptable. The amount of trucks that will be travelling up and down Cumberworth Lane would be very disruptive. Cumberworth Lane is a narrow country road which has very narrow pavements and alot of pedestrians.</p> <p>If driving on Cumberworth Lane toward the village it is very difficult to navigate already around cars parked at the bottom of hill on the opposite side of the road to the Methodist Church down towards the village as due to the way the road bends and the parked cars there is a real blind spot.</p> <p>Access to Denby Dale road from Cumberworth Lane is also difficult due to parked cars opposite the bottom of Cumberworth Lane which narrows the road at the point of exit. The same is also true at the top of Cumberworth Lane with narrow roads and parked cars so increasing the number of large trucks together with the buses and other traffic on the road would be extremely challenging and unpleasant for pedestrians including a large number of children.</p>
