<p>I am writing to register my objection to the above planning application.</p> <p>As a current resident of this village I support the objections raised by other members of the community and wish to add my own concerns:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increased air pollution due to the increase of cars, lorries, machinery, building works and open cast mining. Along with the hazardous health risks from coal dust exposure, such as several respiratory illnesses and long term exposure to fine particulate matter, which can also lead to other serious health conditions.• The small village roads cannot support the volume of lorries and heavy machinery required for construction and site access. This is a massive safety risk to residents and will increase traffic congestion even more so, in the already busy village.• Impact on local schools, local GPs and dental services that are already struggling to provide services to the local people.• Along with the other building developments in the village, it continues to harm the village character, losing its identity and its community feeling.• The local green spaces are slowly disappearing, causing disruption and loss of wildlife.
