Dear Sir or Madam

I would like to place an objection to the above planning application based on the following grounds:

1. There would be an impact on the neighbours, including \_\_\_\_\_ who live away from the proposed development on Hoylake Avenue and ourselves who only live 200m away on Prestwich Drive.
2. There may be parking issues depending upon the number of visitors.
3. There may be noise issues depending upon the ages and number of children actually housed there.

With regards to the care home for children, a care home for children is about creating a safe haven for the children therefore it should not be common knowledge that a group of children live there. In this location of private bungalows owned by mainly elderly people, the proposed usage would make this property stand out significantly from the other surrounding properties and possibly attract unwanted attention from unscrupulous outsiders. A children's care home should be in a more remote secure location where privacy, security and anonymity of the children can be more easily guaranteed. The staffing levels proposed appear to be far below what would be expected for such an establishment.

In conclusion I feel that this proposal is totally unsuited to this location and I would request that permission is refused.
