### Description

Our Plans as follows:

We aim to change 189 Headfield Road, WF12 9JJ from a Residential Home C3 to a Children's Home C2. This type of care home is in extremely high demand to Kirklees Council and will present as a normal family home. Opening a children's home will give two children a chance to live close to where they were born rather than be transferred across the country. In order of opening a children's home, we need to obtain planning permission, mandatory to our application to provide care. Our overall mission is to influence the care system.

189 Headfield Road, represents a family home, this type of property is statistically proven to have more success in the care industry and is also becoming mandatory. The property is capable of housing up to two children in the care system, under the authority of Kirklees Social Services. From this address, we can give two unfortunate children stability and a place to call home, from the ages of 11 years up until 16 years. A mandatory Location Assessment including local Risk Assessments has been completed and has left us very excited about the potential to provide outstanding care in this area.

I have already appointed a manger who will oversee the daily running of the home. Our manager chosen lives locally and will be paid a salary upon opening. This role can be performed from personal home with the occasional visit, roughly once per week. I will also oversee the daily running of the home with the occasional visit, roughly twice a month. We plan to have a staffing ratio of 2 staff members per service user, 24/7hrs inside the property. Our staff will work 24hr shifts including sleeping's. We plan to recruit locally and are offering above than the national living wage with opportunities to take on qualifications and progress throughout our company as it expands.
