<p>I object to this development:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Access to the land is via a very busy road used by Ambulances as it is close to HRI. I have concerns for delays to emergency patients caused by large site traffic and traffic jams especially at school-run times.2. The pathway on Lidget St at the access to the site is heavily used by elderly pedestrians during the day, walking to and from the popular and successful Lindley high st, plus by schoolchildren, not just at opening and closing times, but also during the day, walking buses etc. Having heavy site traffic crossing the pathway will be a potential danger to pedestrians and schoolchildren.3. I am concerned about the impact of development on wildlife on the site.4. I am concerned about the structure of the church and the graves and the impact of the heavy plant vibrations driving constantly in and out of the site plus the vibrations caused by drilling and digging. No church, nor graves, dating back hundreds of years should be placed at risk in order to shoehorn a development into an already congested area.5. I am concerned the above factors will negatively impact the allotments.6. I fully support the objection made by The Manor House. As a regular customer, this development definitely would affect footfall. HD3 is desperately short of high quality hospitality businesses and this development would jeopardise the existence of one of the best in Kirklees, not just HD3.7. The housing on Kirkwood Drive, close to the development, owned predominantly by elderly residents, would experience noise and pollution from engines and dust from early morning which will negatively impact their daily life. They chose to live in Lindley in the latter stage of life as it is peaceful, quiet and has a high street that can provide for their daily needs. A caring council should not be causing them discomfort, stress and a loss of quality of life in their later years.
