<p>I wish to object to the proposals for the following reasons:</p> <p>There will be a substantial increase of vehicles, with 20 designated parking places and additional delivery vehicles adding to the already congested Avenue.</p> <p>The Avenue is already in demand for parking places and the turn around area is used for parking, additional cars would make the Avenue impassable and potentially dangerous when parking or turning vehicles/vans/emergency vehicles around.</p> <p>Emergency vehicles already struggle to access homes along the Avenue and turn around, they will be impeded by the volume of traffic accessing the Avenue.</p> <p>In winter the Avenue is impassable, this winter we had 8 days where we were unable to move our cars or leave the Avenue.</p> <p>The Avenue is not able to accommodate larger vehicles such as lorries, with refuse lorries needing to reverse and sometimes unable to access the Avenue because of parked cars or adverse weather conditions.</p> <p>Halling Lane that leads onto the Avenue, is a narrow 'unkempt' road that is used as a 'short cut' for local traffic, an increase will mean more pollution, noise and potentially make the road more dangerous.</p> <p>Gynn Lane is frequently blocked at school pick up and drop off times, an increase of traffic would make this even more dangerous to pupils at the school than it already is.</p> <p>The proposed positioning of the houses would block sunlight to my property.</p> <p>The proposed houses would mean that I would be overlooked directly into my property and into my garden.</p> <p>The proposed houses would have an impact on wildlife, pollution and noise.</p>
