<p>I have concerns about the local wildlife whose habitats will be destroyed by this development, and the number of establish trees that are going to be cut down. There are deer, badgers, foxes owls, as well as many other bird species, that call this land home. Surely there are other brownfield sites that would cause a lot less disruption.</p> <p>Drainage down the hillside is already terrible. We had to add additional draining in our garden at our own cost, and I believe the developement will only make this worse, even with approval drainage plans in place.</p> <p>The huge social housing estate up at broad oak has all already increased the amount of antisocial behaviour in the area including people have their property damaged.</p> <p>The homes look like they're going to be mainly family homes, yet there is no area for children to play. Jubilee Park leaves a lot to be desired. Only a swing for small children as the climbing frame (which is usually in a state of disrepair) usually just attracts teenagers. There needs to be more provisions for young children.</p> <p>Traffic on Cowlersley Lane is already at breaking point following the Broad Oak. Estate being built, I can't see how it would cope with potentially another 100+cars in the area.</p> <p>The new homes look to seriously impact the privacy of houses that currently exist on Ayres Drive, also blocking sunlight as evening encroaches.</p>
