<p>I am extremely concerned, regarding this planning application, for the detrimental impact it will have on the local environment. The area involved will mean destroying a lovely part of the local area, home to a variety of wildlife, including deers, foxes, rabbits, birds and many more. It is an area of natural beauty, where many trees will be destroyed and is regularly used by locals for walking and dog walking (this has been the case for decades).</p> <p>I am also very worried about the safety of through-traffic on Windsor Road. This road has always been a no- through road and is not very wide, especially with the number of parked cars at both sides (only single file access). It is not a very feasible option for a through-road. Access and safety for construction and emergency services is very questionable, to say the least.</p> <p>The access at the end of Windsor Road is also very unsafe, due to existing parking, both at the end of the road and on the junction with Cowlersley Lane.</p> <p>The volume of traffic on Cowlersley Lane is an issue at peak times and currently builds up quite considerably. This is already a major problem for local residents. This has worsened due to other new housing developments locally. We do not need any more.</p> <p>There are no facilities for new residents locally as doctors, dentists etc. are already at full capacity and are struggling already. The local bus service is atrocious. There is currently, only one bus that actually services Cowlersley Lane. This is very poor for our local people relying on public transport.</p>
