<p>The building of these properties will cause damage to local wildlife, infact some damage has already been done when the owners of the land began clearing the area of trees and shrubs, and creating an alternative entance used by mechanical equipment since summer 2024- which suggests they already assumed that permission would be granted.</p> <p>In this area we have a wide range of wild birds, foxes, hedgehogs and birds of prey- and these are just the ones we have seen!</p> <p>In addition to this, neighbouring properties will be affected by noise polution, possibly being overlooked and sunlight being blocked from windows.</p> <p>When taking into consideration the proposed planning of another 40+ houses on the land opposite this site, this seems like absolute disregard for the local area it's wildlife and the rural aspects enjoyed by the residents.</p> <p>I would have also expected that given the proximity to our house and the fact the drains plan to be positioned at the edge of our back garden that we would have been notified about this in writing.</p> <p>It is worth noting that the notice on the lamppost outside the site was not present for more than 6 days before it vanished.</p>
