After reviewing the tree documentation submitted the proposed plan and tree work looks to be broadly acceptable. However, KC trees isn't convinced that T5 requires removal to facilitate the development. The crown of T5 starts relatively high and could be pruned to facilitate the development. The canopy may still overhang the roof of the new gymnasium, but this shouldn't cause any problems as there is unlikely to be windows located in the roof of a gymnasium and therefore the tree would not restrict light.

It is debatable weather this tree is or isn't included in the TPO and therefore the KC trees is happy to not object to the proposals but request that T5 retained if possible.

The submitted method statement and tree protection plan are sufficient to protect all retained trees and there is no objection on this front either.
